- Note: Colin Veitch played a pivotal role in the 1904-05 season as Newcastle United secured their first-ever First Division League Championship. Operating primarily as a right-midfielder, Veitch appeared in 33 of the club's 34 league fixtures, anchoring a formidable team that famously conceded only 33 goals all season.

- 420 **A Boatmen's Bank Saint Louis cheque**, paid to Harry Hall Knight from the Robertson Aircraft Corporation for the sum of \$1000 dollars, No. 2951, dated Feb 18 1927.
- Note: This check was the first sum of money donated to the syndicate for building the Spirit of St. Louis. The Spirit of St. Louis was the first plane to complete a solo nonstop transatlantic flight, piloted by Charles Lindbergh. It took off from Roosevelt Airfield in Long Island, NY, and after travelling 3,610 miles in 33 hours and 30 minutes, it landed at Le Bourget Field in Paris, France. It won the \$25,000 Orteig Prize and was a key moment in aviation history.
- Provenance: This cheque was initially sold by Sotheby's in a larger lot of other cheques also relating to the funding of the Spirit of St. Louis. These cheques originally came from the Otto Kallir Collection of Aviation History. More information on this cheque and the others is available on the Charles Lindbergh website.

- 421 **A Midland Bank Limited cheque, signed by Richard John Bingham 'Lord Lucan', 7th Earl of Lucan**, to pay the sum of £76.30 to Annabel's, dated 20 February 1974.
- Note: Annabel's is a Private Members' Club in Mayfair and was especially popular with the British aristocracy and the international jet-set in the 1960s and 1970s. It is known to be one of, if not the most, exclusive club in London, and Lord Lucan was well known for having close ties with Annabel's. In 1974, the same year this cheque was dated, Lord Lucan vanished after being suspected of killing his children's nanny and attempting to murder his wife. There have been reported sightings of him across the world, but nothing confirmed. Whether he used his powerful contacts to flee the country and go into hiding or he took his own life it is unknown. He was officially presumed dead on 27 October 1999, with an official death certificate being issued on 3 February 2016.
